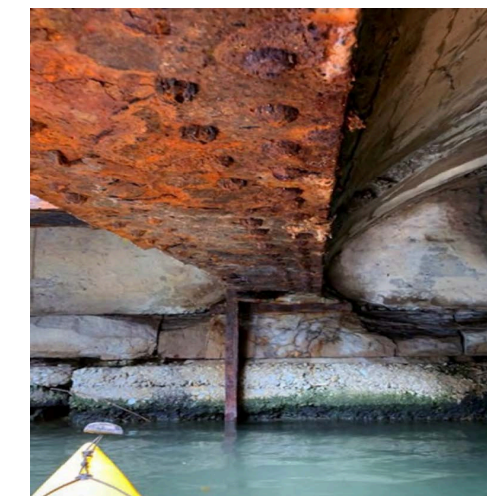
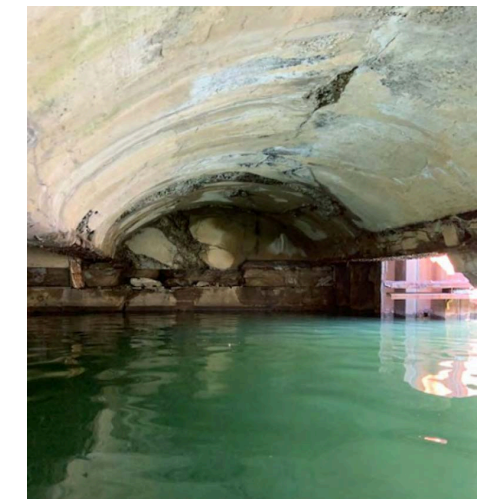


When trick-or-treating first became popular in the United States in the 1800s, more children played mischievous pranks than asked for candy.

300 SOUTH RIVERSIDE IN THE NEWS: THE SEA CAVES OF 300!



On September 13th, architectural journalist Dennis Rodkin featured a unique feature of 300 South Riverside Plaza on his popular radio show on WBEZ, "What's That Building." On a chance kayaking adventure, Dennis ducked under what appears to be a concrete and metal structure just east of the building, on the Chicago River. Once underneath, he discovered curved arches that are the remnants of the Chicago River Reversal Project, from 1900! According to Mr. Rodkin, the "Sea Caves of 300" are the best remaining example of this engineering feat, a huge part of Chicago's history. 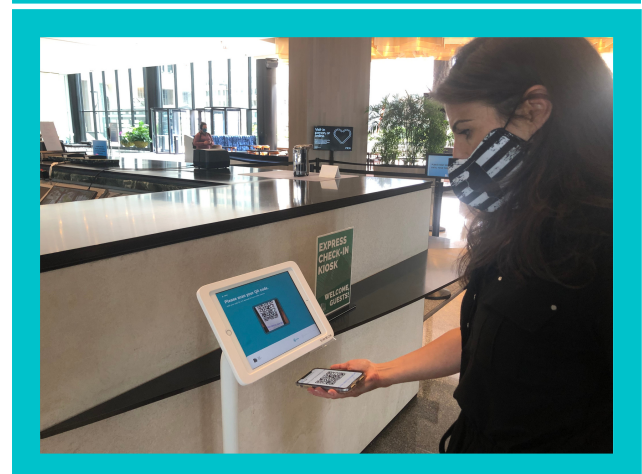
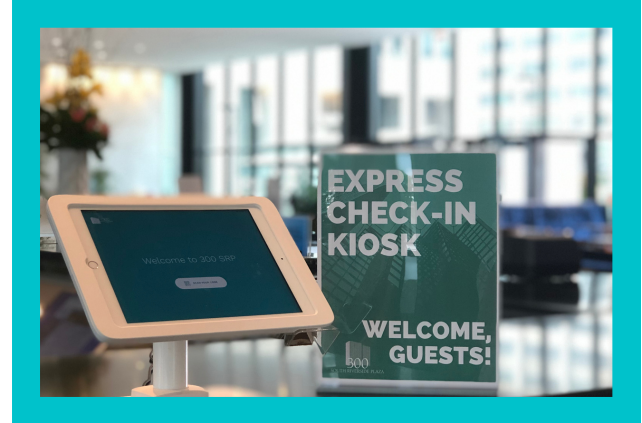
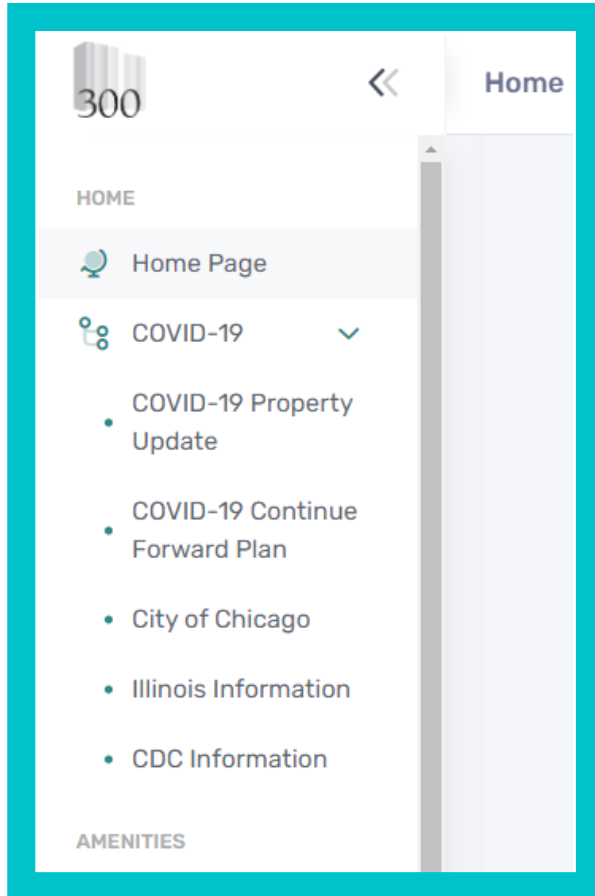
