300SRP will proudly illuminate the North entry monument sign Red for the entire month of February as we continue to support the American Heart Association and their fight to raise awareness as well as reduce deaths that are caused by heart disease and stroke.

About Heart Disease in Women

Women endure unique life experiences such as pregnancy and menopause that can increase their risk of developing cardiovascular disease (CVD). CVD is the #1 killer in women, resulting in 1 of 3 deaths annually. In most cases, about 80% of cardiac and stroke events can be prevented through education and lifestyle changes.

Recognize Symptoms of Heart Attack and Stroke

Symptoms of heart attack and stroke can vary in women and men. Learn some of the following symptoms that can present themselves in both:

- DISCOMFORT IN CHEST
